The event complies with the ESF Master Circus Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website – <u>www.europeansquash.com</u> – all participating MNAs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the guidelines and their requirements.

Categories:

Men: 35+, 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+ Women: 35+, 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+

The TD reserves the right to amalgamate age groups if there are insufficient entries to make a workable draw.

Players may only enter in one category. All players are guaranteed a minimum of three matches.





Eligibility:

The Austrian Masters Open is open to all players over the age of 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65 and 70 on 22th of November 2024, as appropriate, provided the player is not banned under the ESF Master Circus Guidelines. Players must have an active ESID to be able to participate.

ESID:

All players, coaches, managers and other officials must be registered with ESF. Register for a ESID through the ESF tournament software website: <u>https://esf.tournamentsoftware.com</u>

Seedings:

The seeding will be undertaken using the ESF Master Rankings valid at the closing date for entries and in accordance with the ESF Master Circuit Guidelines. All players with an ESF Master Ranking will be seeded by ESF. The Tournament Director is responsible for seeding non-European players who do not have an ESF Master Ranking and about the seeding of local players. The Tournament Director may seek advice from the ESF about the seeding of these players. All participants must be at the venue by the start of play on Friday at 10.00 o'clock.

Matches and Scoring:

All matches will be played as best of five games under the rules of the WSF. Scoring will be PAR 11 to two clear points.

Draws:

Cancellation Conditions

ESF Regulations and Penalties:

The tournament is part of the ESF Master Circuit and will be run in accordance with the ESF Master Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website <u>http://www.europeansquash.com</u>.

Participating MNAs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the guidelines and their requirements.

The following penalties will apply, in accordance with Section E.4 of the ESF Master Guidelines:

- a. If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament (2 days or less before the start date), a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness must be provided to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/ injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF office within two days after the final day of the tournament (email: esf@europeansquash.com; fax +44 1424 774879). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12-month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament. If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12-month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Master Circuit for a period of 12 months.
- b. If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12-month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically. If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12-month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Master Circuit for a period of 12 months.
- c. If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. Illness or injury must be verified by the tournament director and, if possible, by medical certificate sent to the ESF office within two days of the final day of the tournament. If zero points are awarded, the points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12-month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically. If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12-month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Master Circuit for a period of 12 months.
